# Our theory of change: a summary

#### **ULTIMATE OUTCOME**

Survivors of trafficking and exploitation have all they need to recover and build lives that are safe and free.

#### **INTERMEDIATE OUTCOMES**

MENTAL WELLBEING: survivor is able to live safely and independently, and has positive coping skills.

PHYSICAL WELLBEING: survivor knows how to keep physically well, and their home environment is safe.

SAFETY: survivor is free from immediate harm and able to identify and manage risk in people and situations.

ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT: survivor is able to make a safe and sustainable living, and manage their finances.

SOCIAL SECURITY: survivor has positive relationships and a social network.

LEGAL PROTECTION: survivor has access to and awareness of rights and protections.

#### **ENABLERS:** what survivors need in order to reach intermediate outcomes

Understanding of healthy relationships and boundaries / Ability to recognise signs of danger and threat / Confidence and knowledge to self-advocate / Legal representation / Supportive government legislation / Secure immigration status / Appropriate physical and mental health support / A community of belonging / Sense of purpose and meaning / Ability to manage personal finances / Training and education / Benefits / Employment / Community and support groups / A tolerant and compassionate society / Appropriate housing / Understanding of public services and systems

## ACTIVITIES: what we do at Ella's to bring about enablers
